But I thought it important that I circulate to you some information that I promised I would make available ...plus bonus items!

Many of you will be aware that we have been running a survey asking residents and partners about their views on the JSNA key issues. The report was recently included in the Health and Wellbeing Board papers supporting the approach to the first Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy and is now available for wider circulation.

The summary results are attached and provide interesting reading as do the range of ideas that almost 600 respondents provided....thanks to everyone for taking part and the suggestions are being actioned wherever possible.

We also have two refreshed chapters published: Population and Health Inequalities....though you can expect more versions of the population chapter as more Census 2011 is released.

The last bonus item are two new maps that relate male and female life expectancy when plotted by Wirral line Mersey Rail Stations....the data illustrates the known increases in life expectancy as you move from the east of the peninsula though it offers a different perspective when relating the issue to very local landmarks...hope you find it useful.

Finally we hope to circulate very soon the report of the July JSNA 'Un-conference' event, hosted by Voluntary & Community Action Wirral (VCAW) that brought together members of the public to discuss their health and wellbeing issues and concerns. Look out for this in the next bulletin...
