Long Term Conditions (LTC) Chapter Updated (October 2012)

Long Term Conditions Chapter - this has been reviewed and refreshed to include the number of patients registered at GP practices as having a Long Term Condition including visual and hearing impairments, the number of people claiming incapacity benefit and employment support allowance, and the number of adults receiving services to help them live at home for longer. The Population figures will be updated when the 2011 Census data is available.

Drug Chapter - This has been reviewed and refreshed to include more recent national drug treatment monitoring data for Wirral, including new national targets and indicators to monitor drug treatment systems in the North West.

Alcohol Dependency Chapter Updated (October 2012)

Alcohol Dependency Chapter - This has been reviewed and refreshed in line with the latest Local Alcohol Profile for England (LAPE) which mainly consists of benchmarking Wirral against regional and national data relating to alcohol related and alcohol specific admissions, alcohol attributable mortality rates and a range of other alcohol related indicators. New prevalence estimates are also available in the chapter.
